For the last two terms, we have had to chase some parents for fees – we have fixed costs and overheads to bear and will find it difficult to sustain student admissions against unpaid fees so please promptly make your payments. For your convenience, the school office will remain open during holidays from 8:00 am to 12:00 noon.
