School Fees Reminder

As we look ahead to the next academic year, we wish to inform parents of a revision to our school fees. This adjustment reflects the implementation of the **Cambridge Curriculum** and the increased cost of providing external teachers due to rising staff costs. Our new fee structure is as follows:
